

# This is what Good Samaritan Hunger Center does every week of the year:



Five times a week two people take the van and go to grocery stores, Acme Giant Eagle and West Point to pick up breads, sweets, fruits & vegetables. Twice a week these products are picked up from two IGA grocery stores.



Twice a week two people pick up left-overs from Sanese, a vending food distributor. Once a week food is picked up from Longhorn Steakhouse, Olive Garden and Red Lobster



Once a week a driver takes the box truck to the Akron Canton Regional Foodbank to pick up the weekly food order.



Five times a week two or three people come in and cook in the morning with our Kitchen Manager: either a hot meal or soup.



Twice a week two men from Oriana House volunteer to help restock our pantry shelves under the guidance of another long time, regular volunteer.



**Three times a week we serve hot meals:** We travel to at-risk neighborhoods and serve a meal consisting of: a salad, an entrée, a fruit dish, a vegetable dish, bread/butter, dessert and beverage. Five or six students from Walsh Jesuit H.S. and Archbishop Hoban H.S. work out their service hours by serving dinners at 2 of our 3 hot meal sites.



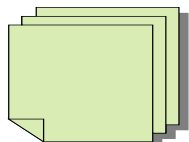
**Two times a week we have our PANTRY DAYS:** Again, we travel to at-risk neighborhoods.



Six men from Oriana House unload groceries from our box truck and with 4-6 client volunteers the grocery bags are filled with: 10 food items from our pantry; 2 or 3 items from Sanese; breads and desserts. Clients may also choose from fresh vegetables/fruit. We offer meat when possible!



Four client volunteers dish up 32 oz. containers of fresh, hot soup!



Three or four volunteers help our clients sign in when they come to pick up groceries. This is a government requirement as we receive USDA food items.

GSHC serves 200 meals/week; gives out 250 bags/week (4 meals/bag)
